

HLTAID003 Provide First Aid



Previously known as Apply first aid or senior first aid. This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance. The First Aid Certificate, HLTAID003, is nationally accredited and providing participants with the qualification to be a First Aid representative in many workplaces and other required situations.

At the Successful completion

- Assess an emergency situation
- Maintain the airway, breathing and circulation of an unconscious casualty
- Administer First Aid for Minor Wounds & Apply Infection Control Procedures
- Manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Manage a casualty suffering from shock
- Administer First Aid for Burns & Electric Shock
- Administer First Aid for Eye & Soft Tissue Injuries
- Manage a casualty suffering Near Drowning/Drowning
- Administer First Aid for Venomous Bites & Stings and Allergic Reactions
- Administer First Aid for Spinal Injuries & Fractures
- Determine Principles for Assessment and Movement of the Sick & Injured & First Aid Recording Requirements
- Explain the legal and social responsibilities of a first aider
- Determine first aid facilities and training requirements

- ✓ Over 18 years old at the time of enrolment
- ✓ A completed application form
- ✓ Identification Documents
- ✓ A photo ID
